

Your Voyager I05 USB Modem Setup Guide (Mac)



Important – if you have any other USB modems installed on your computer these must be uninstalled before continuing.

Microfilter – Sometimes called splitters. You need to ensure that all the devices connected to your phone line are filtered in order for ADSL to work correctly. If you are unsure how the filters that we have provided should be configured then look at the “Wiring and Filters” tutorial, available at <http://usertools.plus.net/tutorials/>.

Your Voyager I05 USB Modem is compatible with Mac OS9 and OSX.

Your Starter Pack should Include: 1 x Voyager I05 USB Modem (illustrated above) 1 x USB cable (blue)
1 x Telephone cable (black) 2 x Microfilters (individually boxed) 1x Installation CD and Setup Guide.

- 1 Download the file '**VoyagerI05**' to a temporary folder on your Hard Disk drive.
- 2 Uninstall the current drivers from your Macintosh. This is achieved by double clicking on the application Uninstall this is under Macintosh HD/Application/BT Voyager I05 ADSL Modem. Follow the on screen instructions.
- 3 Create a new folder on your Hard Disk drive - e.g. Voyager Drivers
- 4 Unstuff the downloaded file **VoyagerI05MAC.sit** to the new folder you have created (you will need to use an unzip utility such as **stuffit** to perform this function.)
- 5 Ensure that the USB cable between the Voyager I05 modem and Macintosh is disconnected.
- 6 Navigate to the new folder Voyager Drivers and double click on the file **BT Installer.app**.

Restart your Macintosh.

Mac OS9

Installation is complete. You will be able to connect to the Internet via Remote Access, this will still have your username and password details you entered previously.

Mac OSX

When your Macintosh has restarted you will need to configure the modem.

- 1 Open the application Internet Connect.
- 2 From the configuration menu select BT Voyager I05.
- 3 To Edit your Username Click the Edit.. button (Mac 10.3 customers need to double click the System Preferences icon in the dock and then select Network).
- 4 The Network window will appear. Select the PPP tab.
- 5 Enter your username and password (Supplied by your service provider).
- 6 Tick the option Save Password.
- 7 Click Apply and Close the Network Window. You will be returned to the Internet Connect application
- 8 Click Connect to make a connection and surf the internet.

Installation is complete. You will be able to connect to the Internet via Remote Access, this will still have your username and password details you entered previously.
